General Study Tips

1. Set a Target – Own Your Goal

2. Prioritize Subjects Smartly

- **PHP & Java** – Focus on logic, theory, syntax, and examples.
- **Mathematics** – Focus on formulas, theorems, and solved problems.

Tip: Cover **80% of your paper** through **20% focused efforts** (PYQs + notes + important topics).

3. Study in Blocks (Not for Hours)

- 25–30 mins deep focus + 5 mins break = brain-friendly learning.
 - Use this time for **revision, short note-making, or solving 1 question**.
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4. Create Your Revision Weapons

- One notebook for **only important Q&A**.
 - One sheet for **formulas, syntax, definitions** (can revise even in auto, on terrace, or at night).
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5. Practice Writing Daily

“The difference between average and excellent is presentation.”

Practice writing at least **1 long answer and 3 short ones daily**.

Improve speed + handwriting + structuring (headings, bullets, underlines).

6. Mock Yourself Before Life Does

- Take mini-tests every 3 days.
 - Use a timer. Sit straight. Attempt with real paper.
 - It trains your brain to **stay calm under pressure**.
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7. Believe in Revision, Not Rote Learning

- Revisit your notes 3 times before the exam.
 - Every revision clears confusion and builds confidence.
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8. Take Care of You

- Sleep 6–7 hours.
 - Walk, talk less negativity, and stay focused.
